This case was set for an evidentiary hearing on July 27, 2020.<sup>1</sup> On July 23, the parties filed a proposed Stipulation and Agreement, and the Commission issued its Order Suspending Procedural Orders and Cancelling Evidentiary Hearing. On August 4, the Commission Staff filed a Request to Delay Ruling on Stipulation. On August 10, the Staff filed a Motion for an Order Requiring Respondents to Respond to a Data Request on Shortened Time and Staff's Status Report, and on August 28, the assigned regulatory law judge conducted a telephone data dispute conference between the parties per Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.090(8)(B). In light of the procedural posture of the case, the Commission will order the parties to file a Status Report.
