

**MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT OR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**


COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") and for its Motion for Extension of Time to File Stipulation and Agreement or Procedural Schedule, states the following:

1. On September 1, 1999, KCPL filed an Application for Approval of the Accrual and Funding of Wolf Creek Decommissioning trust fund at current levels ("Application").
2. KCPL, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the Office of Public Counsel are close to reaching a settlement that probably will result in a Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
3. Together with the Application, KCPL filed the Wolf Creek Generating Station Decommissioning Cost Update ("1999 Study"). Recently KCPL discovered an error in the 1999 Study. The parties cannot reach a Stipulation and Agreement until this error is corrected. Accordingly, KCPL requests additional time to correct this error.
4. All parties agree with this request.
5. KCPL requests an extension of time until December 4, 1999 in which to file. No one will be prejudiced by the grant of additional time in which to file.
