MOTION FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION

COMES NOW Southern Union Company ("Southern Union"), by counsel, and for its Motion for Expedited Consideration respectfully states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

- 1. Southern Union has this date caused to be filed with the Commission an application which is the subject of the captioned matter. The application requests an order of the Commission authorizing Southern Union to acquire up to and including five percent (5%) of the common stock of Pennsylvania Enterprises, Inc. ("PNT").
- 2. As explained in the application, the purpose of the investment authority is to mitigate the pricing effect of possible arbitrage trading in PNT shares prior to the time of closing of the merger and thus to preserve the value of the merger. Accordingly, time is of the essence.

 Arbitrage trading in PNT stock may already be occurring and will likely increase in intensity as the time of pricing approaches.

WHEREFORE in view of the foregoing, Southern Union respectfully moves the Commission to give the subject application expedited consideration and to issue an order approving the application effective July 30, 1999.
