

OnSite Access Local, LLC ("OnSite" or "Applicant"), by its undersigned counsel, hereby applies, pursuant to §§ 392.410, 392.430, 392.440, 392.450, and 392.455, RSMo. 1994; 4 CSR 240-2060(4), and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 Pub. L. No. 104-104, 100 Stat. 56, approved February 8, 1996, for a Certificate of Service Authority to provide resold and facilities-based intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri. Additionally, pursuant to §§ 392.420 and 392.361, RSMo. 1994 OnSite requests that said services be classified as competitive and to waive certain statutes and regulations. In support of its application, OnSite provides the following information.

I. INTRODUCTION

II. QUALIFICATIONS

6. OnSite, a limited liability company organized under the laws of New York on February 7, 1997, is a wholly-owned subsidiary of OnSite Access, Inc., a Delaware holding company. As of January 3, 2000, OnSite is authorized to transact business in the State of Missouri. OnSite's Articles of Organization and a copy of its Certificate of Authority to Transact Business in Missouri are attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2, respectively.

7. OnSite is financially qualified to provide resold and facilities-based intrastate interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri. Through its parent company, OnSite has access to the financing and capital necessary to conduct the telecommunications services as specified in this application. OnSite will rely upon its existing personnel and resources, both technological and financial, to provide intrastate telecommunications services. In support of OnSite's application, attached hereto as Exhibit 3, under seal and subject to a request for confidential treatment, is a copy of the most recent financial statement for OnSite's parent company, OnSite Access, Inc.¹

¹ The submitted financial documents include the predecessor entities of OnSite Access, Inc., as follows: the parent company was originally formed on July 5, 1996, under the name Veritech Ventures LLC. Effective May 18, 1998, the parent company was reorganized under the name OnSite Ventures LLC (*see* 1998 financial statements, note 1). On June 30, 1999, OnSite Ventures LLC was merged into a newly formed corporation under the name OnSite Access, Inc. (*id.*, note 9).

8. OnSite has the managerial and technical qualifications to provide intrastate telecommunications services in Missouri. OnSite's management team has considerable experience in network operations, financial analysis/accounting, marketing, sales, customer service, training, regulatory, and other relevant areas. Attached hereto as Exhibit 4 is a description of the telecommunications experience and expertise of OnSite's key management personnel. As the biographical information of OnSite's key personnel reflects, these individuals have substantial experience in running major telecommunications operations. Each member of OnSite's management team will draw upon his or her own experience, as well as the collective experience of the entire management team, to ensure that OnSite is managed and operated effectively, efficiently, and profitably. Exhibit 3 describes the technical and managerial experience of OnSite's personnel in greater detail.

9. Applicant is currently authorized to provide competitive local exchange telecommunications services in the following states: California, Connecticut, District of Columbia, Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey, and New York. Applicant has a pending application to provide competitive local exchange telecommunications services in Florida, Georgia, Maryland, Minnesota, Oregon, Pennsylvania, and Virginia. In addition, OnSite is currently authorized to provide resold intrastate interexchange telecommunications services, by virtue of certification, registration or tariff requirements, or on an unregulated basis, in California, Colorado, Connecticut, Illinois, Iowa, Montana, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, Utah, and Virginia. Applicant has pending applications to provide such service in Florida, Georgia, Maryland, Minnesota, North Carolina, Oregon and Pennsylvania. As a non-dominant common carrier, OnSite is not required to hold Federal Communications Commission authorization to provide domestic interstate

telecommunications services. Furthermore, Applicant has never been denied any request for authority to provide telecommunications services.

III. PROPOSED SERVICES

10. OnSite proposes to provide resold and facilities-based intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services throughout the State of Missouri and, therefore, seeks statewide authorization.

11. OnSite's proposed services include operator service, all forms of 1+ intraLATA and interLATA long distance services, including 800 and calling card service, and private line services. OnSite's telecommunications services will be available on a full-time basis, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

12. OnSite intends to provide the telecommunications services detailed herein over its own facilities, through the use of unbundled network elements purchased from other certified carriers, through the resale of the services of other carriers, or through some combination thereof as determined by market conditions.

13. OnSite will be providing its services pursuant to the terms and conditions set out in its tariffs. A proposed tariff, bearing a 45 day effective date, which contains the rules and regulations applicable to its customers and a description of services initially offered is attached as Exhibit 5.

IV. CLASSIFICATION AS A COMPETITIVE TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

14. OnSite also seeks classification of its proposed telecommunications services as competitive, pursuant to Mo. Rev. Stat. §392.361, and the accompanying reduced regulation, pursuant to Mo. Rev. Stat. §392.420. Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission suspend,

waive, or modify the application of the following rules and statutory provisions consistent with the Commission's treatment of other competitive interexchange carriers:

15. The above-referenced statutory provisions or regulations, or previous versions thereof, have been waived with regard to other interexchange carriers in Case Nos. TO-99-0142, TO-99-259, TO-90-128, and/or Case No. TA-91-237. These statutory provisions or regulations are principally designed to apply to noncompetitive telecommunications carriers. It would be inconsistent with the goal and purpose of §392.530 to apply them to a competitive telecommunications carrier such as Applicant.

16. OnSite will comply with all orders and regulations of the Commission applicable to providers of competitive interexchange telecommunication services.

17. Applicant will not unjustly discriminate among its subscribers, as prohibited by Section 392.200 RSMo.


V. PUBLIC INTEREST CONSIDERATIONS

18. OnSite submits that the public interest will be served by Commission approval of this Application. Applicant's proposed services will create and enhance competition and expand customer service options, consistent with the legislative goals set forth in Chapter 392 of the Missouri Revised Statutes and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. Approval of this Application also will expand the availability of innovative, high quality, reliable and competitively-priced telecommunications services in the State of Missouri. Through use of Applicant's own facilities, and through access to many facilities-based carriers operating nationwide, OnSite will be able to select the most economical and efficient non-switched local exchange and interexchange services on a route-specific basis and, thus, can provide customers with a better combination of price, quality, and customer services than other carriers. Accordingly, OnSite anticipates that its proposed service will provide its subscribers with better quality services and will increase consumer choice through innovative, diversified, and reliable service and equipment offerings. Thus, grant of Applicant's petition would promote the public interest in the State of Missouri.

WHEREFORE, Applicant, OnSite, requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant the requested Certificate of Authority to provide non-switched local and interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri, classify Applicant's proposed services as Competitive, and grant a waiver of the statutes and regulations referenced above.
