## MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE TO REJECT FILING

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and hereby requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant this *Motion* to Consolidate or in the Alternative to Reject Filing on the following grounds:

- 1. There is currently a pending docket open for the purpose of receiving an application by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT") for authorization to provide in-region InterLATA telecommunications services originating in Missouri pursuant to Section 271 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. The previous case originated when MCl Telecommunications, Inc. filed its *Petition of MCl Telecommunications Corporation for an Investigation Under Section 271 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996* on August 9, 1996. That case was docketed as Case No. TO-97-56.
- 2. The Commission issued its *Order Granting MCI's Motion for Advance Notice*, on September 25, 1997, directing SWBT to file its Section 271 application with the Missouri

Commission such that the Commission would have 120 days notice of any Section 271 application being filed at the Federal Communications Commission.

- 3. By filing this Section 271 application as a new case, with a new case number, SWBT has attempted to circumvent the intent of the Commission's September 25, 1997 *Order*. One of the purposes of the TO-97-56 docket was to assure that all parties who intervened in that case were provided with service of the Section 271 application by SWBT. Specifically, the Commission directed SWBT to notify the Commission as well as the parties to Case No. TO-97-56. (See, September 25, 1997 *Order*, p. 3.).
- 4. The Commission also stated in its September 25, 1997 *Order* that it would establish a procedural schedule and join, as parties to the action, all certificated basic local exchange telecommunications providers, and all such entities that have applied for such certification as of the date of SWBT's filing. (See, September 25, 1997 *Order*, p. 4).
- 5. According to the Certificate of Service on SWBT's *Application*, only the General Counsel for the Commission and the Public Counsel were served with a copy of the *Application*. There has been no service by SWBT, as directed by the Commission, to those parties who were granted intervention in Case No. TO-97-56.
- 6. Because SWBT has not complied with the Commission's September 25, 1997 *Order*, the 120-day advance notice of any Section 271 application with the Federal Communications Commission has not begun to run.
- 7. The Commission should consolidate this case with TO-97-56. Alternatively the Commission should reject SWBT's filing in the present case. The Commission should also direct SWBT to provide notice to all parties listed in Case No. TO-97-56.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth herein, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission consolidate this case with Case No. TO-97-56. Alternatively, the Commission could reject SWBT's filing in Case No. TO-99-227. Staff further requests that the Commission direct SWBT to provide notice to all parties in Case No. TO-97-56.
