Comes now American Farm Bureau, Inc. d/b/a The Farm Bureau Connection ("Farm Bureau" or "the Company"), by and through counsel and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-10.080 and 4 CSR 240-2.015, and for its Supplement To Motion For Extension Of Time To File 1999

Annual Report respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On May 24, 2000, Farm Bureau filed its Motion For Extension Of Time To File 1999 Annual Report. Concurrent with that filing, the Company also attempted to again file an original version of its 1999 Annual Report and same is reflected in various sections of the Company's Motion.
- 2. While the Commission's Records Department did accept the Company's Motion for filing on May 24, 2000, it again rejected the Company's 1999 Annual Report. This time, the reason given was because portions of the Annual Report were contained in attachments and that "all financial information must be included on the form provided".
- 3. Counsel has informed the Company of this second rejection and the reason therefore and has forwarded the original Report back to the Company so that it can re-type in the information contained in the attachments directly onto the Commission's form.
- 4. When counsel receives the revised Report from the Company, counsel will once again attempt to file same at that time. The Company will require a reasonable period of time

within which to make the required revisions and to provide time for counsel to once again file.
