### NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS AND OPPORTUNITY TO INTERVENE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is required to give notice to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies when an application is filed for a certificate of service authority or for competitive classification. §§ 392.361.2 RSMo 1994¹.

The Commission must approve a certificate of service authority for the resale of interexchange telecommunication services or local exchange services if it finds that approving the certificate is in the public interest. § 392.440. The Commission may classify a company as competitive if it finds that all the telecommunications services the company offers are competitive services. § 392.361.3. The Commission waives application of the following statutes and Commission rules for competitive companies as authorized by Sections 392.361.5 and 392.420:
