Dear Commissioners:

On April 9, 2009, The Missouri Public Service Commission issued to Charter Communications Entertainment I, LLC, d/b/a Charter Communications, ("Charter") a Notice of Change, whereby the Commission expanded Charter's Video Service Authorization to include a number of communities, including the Village of Mackenzie, Missouri.

Recently, Charter was informed by St. Louis County, Missouri ("City") that the Village of Mackenzie has been officially annexed into the unincorporated portions of St. Louis County, Missouri. Due to the annexation, the Village of Mackenzie has ceased to be an incorporated municipality.

Pursuant to §67.2685, Charter is advising the Commission that it seeks to remove the Village of Mackenzie, Missouri from its Video Service Authorization list under Case Number KA-2009-0341. Charter has a Video Service Authorization for St. Louis County, which was issued by the Commission on September 10, 2008 under Case Number KA-2008-0074. Charter will continue to provide video services to subscribers who were previously located in the former jurisdiction of Mackenzie, as they now officially reside in St. Louis County, Missouri.
