- 1. The *Stipulation* requires Ameren Missouri to file a notice in this case no less than five business days prior to making a change in its measure and/or incentive amount offering.¹
- 2. Ameren Missouri is changing the incentive level for several measures, discontinuing one measure (programmable thermostats) and adding three new measures related to dual fuel heat pumps.
- 3. In accordance with the *Stipulation*, Ameren Missouri is providing notice of this change. Attached to this pleading is a list of all incentives offered in Ameren Missouri's residential energy efficiency program with the changed incentives highlighted for ease of identifying where changes occurred. Also attached is a copy of the revised web pages.
- 4. All of these changes have been discussed with the stakeholder group prior to this filing.
