MOTION FOR EXPEDITED SCHEDULE OF PROCEEDINGS

Holnam Inc., Lone Star Industries, Inc., and River Cement Company ("MEG Interruptibles") hereby move the Commission to adopt an expedited schedule of proceedings in this matter and submit the following proposed schedule:

- 1) MEG interruptibles direct testimony – July 19, 2000
- 2) Rebuttal testimony by staff and Company – July 28, 2000
- 3) Surrebuttal testimony - August 7, 2000
- 4) Commission hearing – August 10 and 11, 2000
- 5) Simultaneous briefs by all parties - August 22, 2000

Concurrently with the filing of this pleading, the MEG interruptibles are filing suggestions in support of this Motion.

In the event that the Commission grants the Application for Approval of an Interim Alternative Interruptible Rate previously filed by the MEG interruptibles on or about March 20, 2000, the MEG interruptibles would have no objection to a schedule of proceedings incorporating later dates and longer intervals between filing dates.
