MOTION TO EXPEDITE TARIFF APPROVAL OR TO GRANT INTERIM AUTHORITY AND APPROVAL

Comes now Fiber Four Corporation d/b/a Rock Port Long Distance ("Applicant" or "Rock Port") and for its Motion to Expedite Tariff Approval or to Grant Interim Authority and Approval states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

1. On June 25, 1999, Fiber Four Corporation ("Fiber Four") filed its tariff to implement long distance message telecommunications service ("LDMTS"). Fiber Four's tariff proposed a common set of terms and conditions for the provision of LDMTS and individual rate sheets for LDMTS depending upon the affiliated local exchange company ("LEC") in which LDMTS was to be provided. Fiber Four proposed to do business under four fictitious names including the fictitious name Rock Port Long Distance. Although the Commission stamped the tariffs "received" on June 25, 1999, Counsel for Fiber Four was notified on June 28, 1999, that the tariff filling was being rejected because Fiber Four was proposing to do business using more than one fictitious name. Because time was of the essence, Fiber Four sought reinstatement of the tariff filling on July 2, 1999, requesting that the tariff be implemented for an interim period of time until Fiber Four could seek and obtain certificates for each of the fictitious names under which it proposed to do business. Counsel for Fiber Four has now been apprized by the Staff that this tariff will not be approved.

- 2. Accordingly, on this date Fiber Four Corporation d/b/a Rock Port Long Distance is filing an Application for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services and submitting a proposed tariff using only the d/b/a Rock Port Long Distance. It is important that Rock Port Long Distance's toll tariff become effective on July 26, 1999, because Rock Port Telephone Company is in the process of implementing its intraLATA dialing parity plan ("ILDP") as authorized by the Commission in Case NO. TO-99-520. Rock Port Telephone Company's plan calls for the implementation of intraLATA dialing parity in the exchanges served by Rock Port Telephone Company on July 27, 1999. Those customers who do not affirmatively select an intraLATA toll provider by July 27, 1999, will be assigned to Rock Port Telephone Company's affiliated long distance company (i.e. Fiber Four) on this date.
- 3. Because of the delay occasioned by the rejection of the original tariff, Fiber Four now must request expedited approval of its application for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service and expedited approval of its tariff for Fiber Four Corporation d/b/a Rock Port Long Distance in order to be able to provide the service to the customers of Rock Port Telephone Company when it implements ILDP.
- 4. If the Commission cannot approve the application for a certificate and the accompanying tariff in that time frame, Fiber Four requests that the Commission grant an interim certificate effective July 26, 1999, in order that it can provide toll service to the customers of Rock Port Telephone Company.

Wherefore, Fiber Four respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion to Expedite Tariff Approval or to Grant Interim Authority and Approval and for any other relief appropriate in the circumstances.
