### MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Atmos Energy Corporation ("Atmos" or "Company"), pursuant to Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.080(16) and 4 CSR 240-2.065(2), and respectfully moves the Commission for expedited treatment of Atmos' compliance tariff sheet filed on February 25, 2010. In support of its Motion, Atmos states as follows:

- 1. On February 24, 2010, the Commission issued its *Order Setting ISRS Amounts, Rejecting Tariffs, and Directing Filing of Tariffs* ("Order"). In that Order, the Commission rejected the tariff sheet filed by Atmos on December 1, 2009 (YG-2010-0369), authorized Atmos to file an ISRS rate for each customer class in each district as reflected in Appendix B of Staff's Recommendation, and further authorized Atmos to file a revised tariff implementing an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge sufficient to recover the revenues authorized in the Order. Ordered Paragraph 3 provides: "No later than March 11, 2010, Atmos shall file any revised tariff sheets ('tariff') necessary to collect an ISRS as described in paragraph 2, and the Commission's staff shall file a recommendation as to such tariff no later than March 18, 2010." (Emphasis supplied).
- 2. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, Atmos filed its revised tariff sheet in order to comply with the Commission's Order (provided herewith as **Appendix**

- A). This tariff filing carries a proposed effective date of March 27, 2010 (30 days), and was assigned tracking number YG-2010-0525.
- 3. Atmos seeks the Commission's order allowing the proposed tariff sheet to go into effect on March 4, 2010, to coincide with the Company's first billing cycle in March.
- 4. The ISRS process is authorized by Sections 3933.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.265. Its goal is to provide eligible gas corporations with the ability to recover, on a timely basis, certain infrastructure replacement costs outside of a formal rate case filing via the ISRS. The Commission has authorized such an ISRS in this case and there are no further procedures to be completed. Indeed, as the Order reflects, the parties have been in agreement regarding the Staff Recommendation since February 2, 2010, and no other responses were filed by the February 11, 2010 due date. Granting this Motion will afford Atmos the timely rate relief which the Commission has found to be justified. As such, Commission action as requested will be consistent with the public interest as established by the General Assembly and Commission order.
- 5. The subject tariff sheet and this Motion have been filed as soon as possible after the issuance of the Commission's Order discussed herein.

Atmos recognizes that its request will require an expedited recommendation from the Commission's Staff. In Atmos' previous ISRS filing, Case No. GO-2009-0046, upon receiving Atmos' conformance tariff and request for expedited treatment, the Regulatory Law Judge (on October 28, 2008) issued an Order Directing Staff to File Recommendation no later than October 30, 2008. Staff's Recommendation was filed on that date, and the Commission's Order Approving Tariff in Compliance with Commission Order was issued on October 31, 2008 (with an effective date of November 4, 2008, the requested effective date for the subject tariff).

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Atmos respectfully requests the Commission to grant Atmos' Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve Atmos' proposed tariff sheet (YG-2010-0525) effective March 4, 2010.
