MOTION TO FURTHER MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), on behalf of itself; the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission; Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC"); the Missouri Division of Energy, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers; Midwest Energy Consumers Group; the Missouri Division of Energy; the Sierra Club, the Natural Resources Defense Council, and Renew Missouri Advocates (collectively, the "Parties"), and for its Motion to Further Modify Procedural Schedule, states as follows:

- 1. Since February 10, 2020, the Parties have engaged in settlement discussions, and as explained in the original Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule filed on February 11, 2020, have reached an agreement on revenue requirement issues and reserved certain Sierra Club and OPC issues. The Parties have been meeting to discuss rate design issues and have also reached agreement on rate design issues at this time.
- 2. In anticipation of reducing the agreed-upon terms to a definitive settlement agreement, the Parties have authorized Ameren Missouri's counsel to file this motion and to request the Commission modify the procedural schedule in this case as set forth below:
 - a. Suspend the requirement for surrebuttal testimony on rate design issues;
 - b. No other date in the procedural schedule needs to change.

3. This motion does not address or request a modification of the testimony dates contained in the February 11, 2020 order from Commissioner Rupp.
