NOTICE REGARDING TRUE-UP HEARING

COMES NOW Missouri Gas Energy (hereinafter "MGE" or the "Company") and with respect to the reservation of a true-up hearing in this case to take place on January 31 through February 2, 2007, states the following:

1. By virtue of an Order Regarding Procedural Schedule, Test Year and True-Up Hearing dated July 13, 2006 (the "Scheduling Order"), the Commission adopted the Company's suggested test year of the 12 months ending December 2005, updated through June 30, 2006. The Commission also granted MGE's request for a true-up audit and hearing for specified cost components through October 31, 2006.¹ In doing so, the Commission stated as follows:

> The Commission also realizes that if a trueup hearing were scheduled now, it can always be cancelled if the Commission later determines it to be unnecessary.

Accordingly, the Commission established a procedural schedule that reserved the dates January 31 through February 2 for a true-up hearing.²

2. On December 28, 2006, MGE and the Commission's Staff filed

True-Up Testimony as contemplated by the procedural schedule in this case.

Although it will be necessary for the Commission's Report and Order in this case to be based on the 2005 test year information updated through June 30, 2006, and trued-up through October 31, 2006, it does not appear that a true-up hearing will be required because all true-up evidence is already part of the record and there does not appear to be any material dispute as between MGE and Staff concerning the trued-up numbers. Consequently, MGE suggests that the true-up hearing be cancelled.

WHEREFORE, MGE recommends that the true-up hearing scheduled for January 31 through February 2, 2007 in the referenced case, be cancelled for the reasons aforesaid.
