On April 7, 2006, the Manager of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Public Service Commission filed a Complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Blakely Manufactured Homes, a copy of which is enclosed. The Complaint includes a Motion for Expedited Answer by Blakely Homes, alleging that the actions of Respondent pose “enormous public safety concerns.” Generally, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.070, a Respondent has 30 days from the date of this notice to file an answer.
