On April 7, 2006, the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Public Service Commission filed a Complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Four Seasons Manufacturing, Inc. Four Seasons filed its Answer on April 25, 2006. On May 25, 2006, the Commission held a prehearing conference for the parties to discuss settlement and to discuss the schedule by which the Commission will proceed to hear this complaint case.

As of June 23, 2006, the parties have filed neither a procedural schedule nor a settlement proposal with the Commission. The next step is to move this matter toward resolution. To that end, the Commission will order the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule including the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The parties shall submit a procedural schedule by July 14, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on June 26, 2006.
