ORDER DIRECTING RESPONDENT TO SHOW CAUSE

On July 30, 2010, the Commission issued an order setting a prehearing conference to be held on August 12. The Commission also directed 5 Star Homes and Development Company, Inc. to file an answer to the complaint, through an attorney, by the date of the prehearing conference.

In addition to not filing an answer by August 12, 5 Star did not appear at the prehearing conference as directed. Because the company has not complied with the Commission's order, the Commission will direct 5 Star to file a pleading stating why the Commission should not find the company in default and deem the facts, as set out in the complaint, as admitted.

The Commission informs the company that a ruling as such may result in the Commission finding in favor of the Director of Manufactured Housing and Modular Units and granting the relief the Director requests.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. 5 Star Homes and Development Company, Inc. shall file a pleading stating why the Commission should not find the company in default and deem the facts, as set out in the complaint, as admitted.
2. 5 Star Home and Development Company shall file the pleading, set out in ordered paragraph 1, no later than August 31, 2010.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
