COMMENTS OF MISSOURI CABLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ASSOCIATION


COMES NOW Missouri Cable Telecommunications Association (MCTA)
by and through Richard S. Brownlee III, Polsinelli Shughart PC, and for its
Comments to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) in the
above captioned docket states:

1. The Commission should defer to the Missouri Office of
Administration (OA) in terms of information to be gathered
regarding high speed internet access available in Missouri including
data speed, rates, mapping, unserved and underserved areas, and
available funding.
2. OA has received an approximate \$1.9 million grant from the federal
stimulus program to develop the same information and produce
mapping, therefore, if the Commission endeavors to investigate the
same issues and data, there would be unnecessary and costly
duplication.
3. Utilizing and incorporating the OA investigation, protective orders
and documentation will meet MCTA concerns regarding the
confidentiality of materials filed, in light of questions regarding the

Commission's ability to provide such protections through a protective order.

4. The Commission should work with OA and focus on preparing a comprehensive report available to the State that describes the data collected and addresses the other matters of Senate concern raised in the formulation of this docket.
5. The Commission should clarify in its report the source, projected use/areas and amounts of funding for the state available broadband projects.
6. The Commission should accelerate its report to coincide with the completion of mapping to produce a report at the earliest date possible so that if legislative action would be required, there would be time for an appropriate legislative response.
7. The Senate is to be commended for this important project for coordinating the work between the Office of Administration and the Commission.


