On March 8, 2011, AT&T Communications of the Southwest and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri (collectively referred to as "AT&T") filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend and investigate a tariff filed by IntelePeer, Inc.
