## NOTICE CANCELING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On March 8, 2011, AT&T Communications of the Southwest and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri (collectively referred to as "AT&T") filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend and investigate a tariff filed by IntelPeer, Inc. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a separate motion echoing that of AT&T. The Commission suspended the tariff and set a time for responses to the motion and for interested parties to intervene. No responses were filed.

The Commission scheduled a procedural conference for April 7, 2011. On April 6, 2011, Staff indicated to the judge that IntelPeer will be withdrawing its tariff. The scheduled procedural conference will be cancelled.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural conference scheduled for April 7, 2011, at 10:30 a.m., is cancelled.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
