On January 17, 2007, CenturyTel of Missouri, L.L.C., Spectra Communications Group L.L.C. d/b/a CenturyTel and Windstream Missouri, Inc., filed a petition seeking leave to file an *Amicus* brief in support of approval of Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri's tariff. Because the tariff in dispute has an effective date of February 16, 2007, and because the Commission must rule promptly on this matter, the Commission will order that any party wishing to respond to the petition for leave to file an *Amicus* brief shall do so no later than January 22, 2007.
