Date: September 26, 1990

Case No. A0-87-48 was established November 3, 1986, to investigate the revenue effects of the Tax Reform Act of 1986 (TRA) on Missouri utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

There have been no audit activities related specifically to this docket for at least a year, and the Staff has no plans to initiate such activities in the foreseeable future. As a result, the Staff recommends that Case No. AO-87-48 be closed. In the event further TRA investigations are necessary in the future, Staff will request a new docket be opened.
