- 1. On May 24, 2000, Opex filed its Motion For Extension Of Time To File 1999 Annual Report. Concurrent with that filing, the Company also attempted to again file an original version of its 1999 Annual Report and same is reflected in various sections of the Company's Motion.
- 2. While the Commission's Records Department did accept the Company's Motion for filing on May 24, 2000, it again rejected the Company's 1999 Annual Report. - 4. When counsel receives the revised Report from the Company, counsel will once again attempt to file same at that time. The Company will require a reasonable period of time within which to make the required revisions and to provide time for counsel to once again file.
