

**ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE ANNUAL REPORT
AND CLOSING CASE**

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-10.080(1), "[a]ll public utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file an annual report with the commission on or before April 15 of each year."

On June 19, 2000, Williams Communications, Inc. d/b/a Vyvx, Inc. (Williams) requested an extension of time to file its 1999 annual report. Williams stated that it had intended to file its annual report with the Commission on or before April 15. Williams stated that the annual report was not filed with the Commission by April 15 because the employee responsible for filing the annual report left Williams' employment prior to April 15 without filing the report. Williams stated that in the process of examining the employee's responsibilities, it came to Williams' attention that the annual report had not been filed. Williams stated that it simultaneously filed the annual report along with its request for extension of time to file the annual report. On June 23, 2000, Williams submitted a complete copy of its annual report because the first copy filed June 19, 2000, had inadvertently been copied on one side only and contained only one side of each page of the document.

The Commission finds good cause for Williams' failure to timely comply with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-10.080(1) and shall grant Williams an


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extension of time to file its annual report, accepting the complete copy of the annual report filed on June 23, 2000, as timely filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Williams Communications, Inc. d/b/a Vyvx, Inc.'s Request for Extension of Time for Filing Annual Report filed June 19, 2000, and supplemented on June 23, 2000, is granted, and the annual report filed on June 23, 2000, is deemed timely filed.
2. That this order shall become effective on October 5, 2000.
3. That this case may be closed on October 6, 2000.
