MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its Motion for Extension of Time to file Staff Recommendation, states as follows:

- 1. On June 7, 2000, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) filed its request for an exemption from the requirements of 4 CSR 240-40.017 (the HVAC rule) pursuant to subsection (8) of that rule. In its filing, MGE noted that it has challenged the lawfulness of this rule, and did not acquiesce to the lawfulness of the rule by making this filing. However, Staff would note that the HVAC rule is currently effective for all regulated gas corporations operating in Missouri.
- 2. On June 22, 2000, Staff sent MGE a data request seeking information necessary for Staff to make a recommendation to the Commission concerning MGE's request for waiver.
- 3. On August 9, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing in which it ordered the Staff to file its recommendation in the case no later than September 8, 2000.
- 4. Since the original data request was sent, the Staff has made additional requests for information and, while some information has been received, Staff has not received adequate information to make a recommendation that MGE be granted its requested waiver.
- 5. MGE has committed to providing the information requested to the Staff no later than September 15, 2000.

6. Staff requests an Extension of Time in which to file its Recommendation in this case.

MGE agrees with the request for extension and the Office of the Public Counsel does not object to this request.. No one will be prejudiced by the grant of additional time in which to file.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests the Commission grant an extension of time until September 29, 2000 for Staff to file its Recommendation in this case
