MOTION TO OPEN CASE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its Motion to Open Case states:

- 1. The Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") has the authority to establish a case for the purpose of receiving information from the public utilities under its jurisdiction pursuant to Section 393.140 RSMo 1994. Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede") is a gas corporation as defined in Section 386.020(18) RSMo (Supp. 1999) and, as such, is a public utility subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Section 386.020(42) RSMo (Supp. 1999).
- 2. Missouri Natural Gas, a division of Laclede, provides natural gas service to a single-family residence at 416 Boyce, Farmington, Missouri.
- 3. On March 25, 2000, natural gas was ignited, causing a subsequent fire at 416 Boyce, Farmington, Missouri.
- 4. As a result of the ignition of natural gas and subsequent fire, the residence sustained smoke and fire damage estimated at over ten thousand dollars, and one individual suffered minor flash burn injuries.
 - 5. Staff has initiated a formal investigation into the incident.

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully requests that the Commission open a case for the purpose of receiving information, including a Gas Incident Report, concerning the incident at 416 Boyce, Farmington, Missouri.
