STAFF'S MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE CASES

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and for its Motion to Consolidate Cases states as follows:

- 1. The parties in Cases Nos. ST-2000-694 and WT-2000-695 are the same.
- 2. The subject matter in issue in Case No. ST-2000-694 is a proposed increase to sewer service connection fees and the subject matter in issue in Case No. WT-2000-695 is a proposed increase to water service connection fees.
- 3. The Office of the Public Counsel and Staff have raised in their Motions to Suspend Tariff that created both cases the same concerns that the proposed increases may be due to Warren County Water and Sewer Co. opting to perform boring for new connections rather than less expensive road cuts as a result of complaints from it having performed shoddy work on road cuts in the past.
 - 4. The procedural schedules for each case proposed by the Staff are the same.
- 5. The Regulatory Law Judge presiding in this case has requested the Staff to file motions to consolidate these cases.

6. Economy of resources and avoidance of duplicative effort will be served by consolidation of Cases Nos. ST-2000-694 and WT-2000-695, and no party will suffer prejudice by such consolidation.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, the Staff requests that the Commission consolidate the above cases for all purposes.
