### MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (Company or AmerenUE), and hereby requests an extension of time to file the status report called for by paragraph 15 of the Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Commission in this docket. In support of its Motion, AmerenUE states as follows:

- 1. On September 9, 2008, the Commission approved a Stipulation and Agreement between AmerenUE, the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO), and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers respecting AmerenUE's continued participation in the Midwest ISO.
- 2. Paragraph 15 of the Stipulation and Agreement provides that AmerenUE will provide a status report respecting the progress of discussions with the Midwest ISO regarding the risks outlined in paragraph 12 of the Stipulation and Agreement. This status report was due to be filed and provided to the Stakeholders (as defined in the Stipulation and Agreement) by December 1, 2008.
- 3. Given commitments to the Company's current rate case (which as the Commission knows began November 20 and will not end until December 12), the undersigned counsel for AmerenUE, who handled this docket for the Company, has been unable to consult

with all of the Company personnel necessary to compile the information needed for the status report.

4. Given these rate case commitments, the Company requests the Commission extend the due date for the status report to Monday, December 22, 2008. The Company would note that the Midwest ISO stakeholder process mentioned in paragraph 12 of the Stipulation and Agreement is not yet complete, and that process did not start as early as the Midwest ISO originally planned. It is thus possible the Company might have more to report by December 22 than it could report at this time.

WHEREFORE, AmerenUE respectfully requests that the Commission grant it an extension of time to December 22, 2008 to file the above-referenced status report.
