MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND THE APPLICATION FOR WAIVER CONCERNING KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S FILING DATE FOR ITS NEXT INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLAN SUBMISSION

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and, pursuant to Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(20), moves the Commission for leave to amend its "Application for Waiver Concerning Kansas City Power & Light Company's Filing Date for its Next Integrated Resource Plan Submission" ("Application") previously filed in this matter on August 5, 2010. In support of its Motion, KCP&L respectfully states as follows:

1. As reflected in the Commission's Order Directing Notice and Establishing

Time to Respond to Application for Waiver ("August 5th Order") entered herein, "On

August 5, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed an application
asking the Commission to waive a provision of its Electric Utility Resource Planning
(IRP) regulation to allow KCP&L to delay filing its next IRP submission from August 5,
2011, until April 1, 2012." (August 5th Order, page 1). At the time of submitting its
Application, it was KCP&L's understanding and belief that August 5, 2011 was the next
scheduled filing date under the existing Chapter 22 rule. However, KCP&L has since
determined that its next IRP filing actually is due on November 5, 2011, pursuant to the
terms of the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement dated February 17, 2007, in Case
No. EO-2007-0008, which provides in part: "KCPL's next three year IRP filing will be
filed on November 5, 2011 (the "2011 Filing"), assuming there are no changes to the

Electric Utility Resource Planning Rules, 4 CSR 240-22 (Chapter 22), that preempt this

filing schedule." (Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, page 2).

2. Accordingly, the references to the August 5, 2011 date in the Application

have been changed to reflect the correct November 5, 2011 date, in the attached Amended

Application.

Pursuant to the Commission's August 5th Order, any party has the 3.

opportunity to respond to KCP&L's Application for Waiver until September 7, 2010.

Whereas it is important to correct the record herein and such corrected date does not alter

the relief requested, KCP&L respectfully submits that no party will be prejudiced and that

good cause exists for the granting of this Motion. KCP&L is authorized to state that the

Commission Staff supports the specific relief requested in this Motion.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, KCP&L respectfully requests that the

Commission grant it leave to file the attached Amended Application for Waiver Concerning

Kansas City Power & Light Company's Filing Date for its Next Integrated Resource Plan

Submission, and grant KCP&L an extension of time to file its next IRP submission until

April 1, 2012.
