NOTICE REGARDING "FINAL EARNINGS REPORT"

COMES NOW Union Electric Company (d/b/a AmerenUE and referred to herein as "the Company" or "AmerenUE") and submits this Notice Regarding "Final Earnings Report." In explanation of this filing, the Company states as follows:

Section 7.f.iv. of the Stipulation and Agreement submitted and approved in the above styled case, states that a "final earnings report and proposed Sharing Report will be filed in the New Plan Docket within 105 days after the end of the Sharing Period. The final earnings report will provide the actual results of the Sharing Period to be examined."

On September 27, 1999, the Company submitted its "Preliminary Earnings and Sharing Report." In that filing, the Company stated that because various issues remained unresolved from the previous sharing period, the amount of the credit and the magnitude of the rate reduction remained unknown. That situation still exists.

As indicated in the September 27th cover letter, the Preliminary Earnings Report used the Company's position on the contested issues and the Company's final position on the rate

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decrease as applied to the current sharing period's sales. No changes have come to the Company's attention in the brief time since the Preliminary report was submitted.

Accordingly, until a final order is issued in the pending case before the Commission, covering the Third Sharing Period in Case No. EO-96-14, and all matters associated therewith are finally resolved, the Company is unable to calculate the sharing credit for the first sharing period in Case No. EM-96-149, or the rate reduction called for in that case.

Section 7.f.x. of the Stipulation and Agreement states that "Signatory parties to this Stipulation And Agreement will have thirty (30) days after a final report is filed to provide notice that there may be areas of disagreement...." Obviously, since the Company is unable to file a Final Report, the thirty-day period will not commence until such a report is filed.
