**MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT OR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its Motion for Extension of Time, states as follows:

1. On September 1, 1999, Kansas City Power & Light (KCPL) filed an Application for Approval of the Accrual and Funding of Wolf Creek Decommissioning trust fund at the current levels.

2. There have been no intervenors in the case.

3. The Staff, Office of the Public Counsel, and KCPL are in the process of settlement discussions which the parties believe will result in a Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement for submission to the Commission, and find that they need additional time to continue discussions and complete the Stipulation and Agreement.

4. The Parties request an extension of time until November 4, 1999 in which to file either a Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement or a Proposed Procedural Schedule. No one will be prejudiced by the grant of additional time in which to file.

**WHEREFORE**, the parties respectfully request the Commission grant an extension of time to November 4, 1999, to file a Stipulation and Agreement or, in the alternative, a procedural schedule if discussions are not successful.
