### MOTION FOR FINDING OF NECESSITY OF RULEMAKING

COMES NOW the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Director" and "Program"), by and through the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Office of General Counsel, and for his Motion for Finding of Necessity of Rulemaking ("Motion") states as follows:

- 1. Attached, as Attachment A is the Director's recommendation to the Commission on the proposed rulemaking rescission.
  - 2. The Director proposes to rescind Rule 4 CSR 240-122.
- 3. This rulemaking rescission is necessary because, due to the passage into law of Senate Bill 359, recreational vehicle regulation was removed from Commission jurisdiction as of August 28, 1999.

WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully requests that the Commission, based upon the above, find that the proposed rescission of 4 CSR 240-122 (Recreational Vehicles), is necessary to update and make uniform the rules pertaining to manufactured housing.

4 CRS 240-122 - Recreational Vehicles is being rescinded because the Public Service Commission no longer regulates recreational vehicles.

Pursuant to Senate Bill No. 359, which was passed and became effective August 28, 1999, all Public Service Commission recreational vehicle regulations were repealed.

Due to the passage of SB 359, recreational vehicle regulation was removed from Public Service Commission jurisdiction. A fiscal impact representing a loss of revenue of approximately \$260,000 resulted from this legislation. The Department is currently developing a new fee structure to compensate for the revenue loss.

Staff recommends that 4 CRS 240-122 - Recreational Vehicles be rescinded as reflected.
