MOTION TO REVISE RATE PHASE-IN
PLAN, AND TO ALLOW TARIFFS TO
BECOME EFFECTIVE ON LESS
THAN 30 DAYS NOTICE

Union Electric Company respectfully moves that the Commission: (1) approve the revisions to its rate phase-in plan, as described below, in order to reflect the Tax Reform Act of 1986; and (2) permit the tariff sheets reflecting the initial adjustment to the phase-in plan to become effective on less than thirty days notice. In support of this Motion the Company states:

1. The Company is proposing to voluntarily reflect in its tariffs the lower federal tax rates approved in the Tax Reform Act of 1986. This change would be accomplished by reducing the scheduled rate changes in the rate phase-in plan adopted in the Company's last rate case, Nos. E0-85-17 and ER-85-160. The rate increases presently scheduled, and the increases as proposed by the Company to reflect the Tax Reform Act, are as follows:

The derivation of the proposed revenue levels is shown on the two page summary sheet attached hereto.

2. The revised phase-in plan provides for overall annual revenue increases from 1987 through 1990 of approximately 4.6%, compared to increases in those years of 7.3% in the original phase-in plan. This change generally was reflected in the proposed class revenue levels and corresponding rate values by scaling down proportionately the increases which would have taken effect under the original phase-in plan. One exception was the monthly customer charges, which are the same in the proposed tariffs as in the original phase-in. (Also, the revised tariffs reflect a "reactive charge" for 4(M) and 10(M) customers, which was approved after the phase-in plan was first adopted.) The proposed rates were verified by utilizing the same customer billing data from which the original phase-in rates were developed.

3. The tariff sheets which will implement the proposed adjustments to the 1987-1990 rate increases are attached hereto and filed herewith. Tariff sheets for the years 1991 and 1992 (which reflect rate design changes only) have not yet been compiled, but will be filed as soon as they are completed. The tariffs for the 1987 increase have a proposed effective date of April 9, 1987, the date on which the next phase-in increase is scheduled. All of the Company's customers will benefit from the proposed reduction in the rate increase, and thus there is good cause for allowing the next increase to take effect on less than thirty days notice.

4. In the Company's last rate case, the Commission specifically ordered that future phase-in rate increases will take effect automatically. As the Commission stated:

the authorization of tariff sheets which would automatically take effect is appropriate for three reasons: (1) ratepayers

will be able to plan their budgets for electric costs and alter their consumption patterns accordingly; (2) UE will have an incentive to postpone rate filings for several years; and (3) UE and the investment community will have an assurance that the phase-in plan is in effect, thereby eliminating any perceived risk or uncertainties regarding the ultimate inclusion in rates of the allowed Callaway capital costs and deferred equity. The elimination of uncertainties will enable UE to obtain a lower cost of capital benefitting both shareholders and ratepayers. (Report and Order, Case Nos. EO-85-17 and ER-85-160, p. 134).

The provision for automatically implementing the future phase-in increases is of vital importance to the Company, for the reasons cited by the Commission. It is likewise crucial to the Company that the automatic nature of the revised increases not be altered in this process of voluntarily reducing the amount of the scheduled increases. Therefore, to eliminate any possible uncertainty in this regard, the Company respectfully asks as part of this Motion that the revised phase-in tariffs attached hereto be made automatically effective on the dates specified on the tariffs, to the same extent and under the same conditions as the phase-in rates approved by the Commission as part of the original phase-in plan.

5. The Company must also insure that by proposing a reduction of the scheduled phase-in increases, it is not somehow left with no increases -- or that all or a part of the reduced increase is not subsequently voided by a court and/or made subject to refund. That could conceivably occur if any party appealed the granting of this Motion on the ground, for example, that the party was not given the opportunity for a hearing. While the risk of that occurring may be small, the potential loss to the Company is quite large. The Company is naturally reluctant to assume any such risk in the process of voluntarily reducing the level of its authorized rate increases. Thus in order to protect itself against such a loss, the Company expressly

reserves the right to withdraw this Motion without further notice if anyone objects in this proceeding to the amount of the increases proposed in paragraph 1 above, to the class allocations or rate design incorporated into the revised tariff sheets, or to any other aspect of the Company's proposal. If the Company does find it necessary to withdraw this Motion, it would implement the full phase-in increase as presently authorized. This provision is intended to insure that no party attempts to take advantage on some legal technicality of the Company's voluntary efforts to reduce the amount of the rate increases already authorized.


6. To insure that no party can claim a lack of due process, and thus jeopardize the April 9 increase, the Company respectfully asks that the Commission promptly issue an Order setting a date for any written objections to this Motion by other parties, and/or to convene a hearing at which any objections could be raised. If a hearing is convened, the Company respectfully suggests it be held either March 30, 31, or the morning of April 3. The Company is authorized to state that those dates and times are also acceptable to Staff, Public Counsel, and the intervenors represented by Mr. Robert C. Johnson.

7. Company personnel will of course make themselves available to the Commission at any time to answer any questions regarding its proposal to implement the Tax Reform Act.

Wherefore, for the reasons set forth above, Union Electric Company respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion, thereby approving (1) all of the revisions to the Company's rate phase-in plan as described above (including the automatic nature of the future increases to the same extent as the phase-in increases authorized by the Commission in the Company's last rate case); and (2) the implementation of the initial rate change on less than thirty days notice.






