MOTION FOR CORRECTION OR CLARIFICATION

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC” or the “Company”), and for its Motion for Correction or Clarification of the Missouri Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) Report and Order issued May 2, 2018, in the above-referenced matter states as follows:

1. On page 2 of the *Report and Order* under “Appearances” for Missouri-American Water Company, it states:

“Timothy Luft and Roger W. Steiner, Kansas City Power & Light Company, 1200 Main Street, 16th Floor, Kansas City, MO 64105”

While Mr. Luft is one of the attorneys of record for MAWC, his address should be 727 Craig Road, St. Louis, MO 63141. In addition, Mr. Steiner is the attorney for Kansas City Power & Light Company, an Intervenor and a separate party to this case.

2. On page 8 of the *Report and Order*, paragraph 9 under General Findings of Fact, the following statements appear:

“Both the Company and Staff performed a Class Cost of Service (“CCOS”) Study. As part of a settlement, the parties agreed to use Staff’s calculation for billing determinants.”

While the parties did agree to a set of billing determinants, which were attached to the Stipulation and Agreement as Attachment A, the stipulated billing determinants were not the same as those proposed by Staff in this case. MAWC believes that a more accurate statement is as follows:

“Both the Company and Staff performed a Class Cost of Service (“CCOS”) Study. As part of a settlement, the parties agreed to use Staff’s

Class Cost of Service Study for allocating costs among districts and among customer classes.”

3. At page 35 of the *Report and Order*, it states:

“MAWC seeks to increase the monthly customer charge for all 5/8” meters to \$10.00.”

More accurately, it was Company’s proposal to decrease the monthly customer charge for 5/8” meters from \$15.33 to \$10.00 and to increase the customer charge for quarterly billed customers from \$22.35 to \$30.00. (This is consistent with Finding of Fact No. 73, p. 33 of the *Report and Order*.)

4. Ordered paragraph 2 (*Report and Order*, p. 36) provides:

“The tariff sheet submitted on June 30, 2018, by Missouri-American Water Company, assigned Tariff Nos. YW-2017-0276 and YW-2017-0277, are rejected.”

The correct date on which the tariff sheets initiating this case were submitted was June 30, 2017.

WHEREFORE, in light of the foregoing, the Company requests the Commission issue its Order correcting or clarifying its *Report and Order* as requested herein, and for such other orders as are appropriate in the circumstances.
