MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), moves the Commission for expedited treatment of MAWC's tariff sheet, filed on July 8, 2009:

- 1. On July 8, 2009 (effective July 18, 2009), the Commission issued its Order Approving Adjusted an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge.
- 2. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, MAWC filed a tariff sheet in order to comply with the Commission Orders (P.S.C. MO. NO. 6, 8th Revised Sheet No. RT 18.0) (attached hereto as <u>Schedule A</u>). This tariff sheet carries a proposed effective date of August 7, 2009 (30 days), and was assigned tracking number YW-2010-0017. MAWC's EFIS filing indicated that it would seek to have the tariff sheet made effective as of July18, 2009.
- 3. The ISRS process is authorized by Sections 393.1000 through 393.1006 RSMo, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.650. Its goal is to provide eligible water corporations with the ability to recover, on a timely basis, certain infrastructure replacement costs outside of a formal rate case filing via the ISRS. The Commission has authorized such an ISRS in this case and there are no further procedures to be completed in this case. Granting this Motion will afford MAWC the timely rate relief which the Commission has found to be justified. As such, Commission action as requested herein will cause no negative effect on MAWC's customers or

the public generally.

- 4. Accordingly, MAWC seeks the Commission's order allowing the proposed tariff sheet to go into effect on July 18, 2009, or as soon thereafter as the Commission finds to be reasonable.
- 5. The subject tariff sheet and this Motion have been filed as soon as possible after the issuance of the Commission's Order Approving an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, MAWC respectfully requests the Commission to grant MAWC's Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve MAWC's proposed tariff sheet (YW-2010-0017) effective July 18, 2009, or as soon thereafter as the Commission finds to be reasonable.
