**MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

COMES NOW Atmos Energy Corporation ("Atmos" or "Company"), pursuant to Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") Rules 4 CSR 240-2.065(2) and 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), and respectfully submits its Motion for Expedited Treatment in the above-referenced matter. In support of its Motion, Atmos respectfully states as follows:

1. On this date, Atmos filed revised tariff sheets reflecting recent decisions of the Atmos Energy Conservation and Efficiency Program Collaborative Members to expand the existing rebate program and to file a Variance to the Atmos Residential Low Income Weatherization Assistance Program, which recognizes the continued need for increased flexibility for Community Action Agencies in utilizing the massive increases in federal weatherization funding (ARRA). This tariff filing was assigned Tracking No. JG-2010-0245, and a copy is attached and incorporated herein by reference.

2. These revised tariff sheets reflect a thirty (30) day effective date, November 1, 2009. However, in order to allow the Community Action Agencies to utilize the increased flexibility afforded by the subject variance and to permit the expanded rebate terms to be effectuated as soon as possible, Atmos is respectfully requested expedited treatment of these tariff revisions.

3. In accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240.2-080(16), Atmos requests that the Commission act as soon as reasonably possible given the Commission's

Agenda schedule. As stated above, expeditious approval of these tariff revisions will benefit Atmos' customers and the general public by providing Community Action Agencies greater flexibility in the utilization of increases in federal weatherization funding (ARRA) by redirecting funds allocated to Atmos' Residential Low Income Weatherization Assistance Program. Similarly, the expanded terms of the existing rebate program will be available to participating customers sooner, all to their benefit. There will be no negative effect on Atmos' customers or the general public if the commission acts as requested herein.

4. As the subject revised tariff sheets were filed this date, this pleading was filed as soon as it could have been. As discussed above, the tariff Variance will allow Community Action Agencies to redirect funds allocated for the Atmos Residential Low Income Weatherization Assistance Program in accordance with a First Amendment to the Cooperation and Funding Agreement. That First Amendment has been circulated to the Parties to the Agreement for execution and the respective signatures are being obtained at this time.

5. Atmos is authorized to state that the Staff of the Commission does not object to the specific relief requested in this motion.

WHEREFORE, Atmos Energy Corporation respectfully submits its Motion for Expedited Treatment and respectfully requests that the Commission grant the relief requested herein.
