## **MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its motion states:

- 1. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.085 authorizes a party to file a motion for a protective order to treat information as highly confidential or proprietary.
- 2. NeuStar has submitted to the Staff a letter setting forth the prices that is would charge the industry to conduct number pooling trials in Missouri. NeuStar asks that the letter be treated as confidential and proprietary.
- 3. Section 386.480 RSMo 2000 provides that no information furnished to the Commission, except such matters as are specifically required to be open to public inspection by this chapter or by Chapter 610, RSMo, shall be open to public inspection except on order of the Commission, or by the Commission or a Commissioner in the course of a hearing or proceeding.
- 4. By analogy, the State Sunshine Law allows the government bidding process to be closed to public inspection, thereby recognizing that harm may occur if such information is made public. See § 610.021(11), (12) RSMo 2000.
- 5. Based on NeuStar's request that the letter be treated as proprietary and confidential, the Staff believes that the information is not available in any other public document.

WHEREFORE, the Staff requests the Commission to issue its standard Protective Order.
