

2. Applications to intervene must be filed no later than November 18, 2016. Anyone applying to intervene shall offer any objections to, or comments about, AT&T Missouri's filing at the time they file their application.
3. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding AT&T Missouri's filing no later than December 9, 2016.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
