Dear Judge Woodruff:

On December 31, 2020, Liberty filed an application pursuant to RSMo. §§393.1009-393.1015 and Commission Rules 20 CSR 4240-2.060, 2.080, and 3.265, requesting that the Commission authorize changes to the Company’s Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (“ISRS”).

On January 14, 2021, Liberty filed a revised ISRS tariff sheet with a proposed effective date of March 15, 2021. The Staff of the Commission and Liberty have worked diligently to identify, process, and examine the Company’s ISRS-eligible costs, and this process continues. To allow additional time for Staff’s review and a decision from the Commission, Liberty voluntarily extends the ISRS tariff effective date from March 15 to June 1, 2021.
