1. **Chris B. Giles** is employed by KCPL as Vice President, Regulatory Affairs. His responsibilities include all aspects of regulatory activities, including cost of service, rate design, revenue requirements, and tariff administration. Mr. Giles graduated from the University of Missouri at Kansas City in 1974 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics and in 1981 with a Master of Business Administration degrees with concentrations in accounting and quantitative analysis. 2. **Randy L. Hughes** is employed by KCPL as Manager, Resource Planning. His responsibilities include the evaluation and recommendation of alternatives associated with supply-side resources. He also has worked in various positions for Kansas City Power & Light since 1979. Those positions included Generation Engineering, Generation Planning, Superintendent of Fuel Management, Assistant to the Plant Manager, Assistant Manager in Distribution, Commercial Manager in Customer Services and Manager of Generation Resource Planning. Mr. Hughes received a Masters Degree in Business Administration from Rockhurst College in Kansas City, Missouri. He received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Missouri, Rolla.

3. **Harold G. Wyble** is employed by KCPL as Supervisor, Transmission Planning. His responsibilities include various aspects of transmission planning. He also has worked in various positions for KCPL since February, 2001, including Project Engineer, Transmission Planning, Senior Engineer, Transmission Planning, and Supervisor, Transmission Planning. From May 1976 to February, 2001, Mr. Wyble worked in various engineering and system planning positions for St. Joseph Light & Power Company. He has also served on the Southwest Power Pool Generation Interconnection Task Force. Mr. Wyble is also a Registered Professional Engineer and NERC Certified System Operation—Reliability. Mr. Wyble received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering, and a Masters of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering both from the University of Missouri.
