KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S MOTION TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075 and the Order Setting Procedural Schedule, Notice of Hearing, and Order Directing Notice issued by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") in the above-captioned proceeding on May 2, 2011, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") hereby requests intervention to become a party herein. In support thereof, KCP&L states as follows:

- 1. KCP&L is a Missouri corporation, in good standing in all respects, with its principal office and place of business located at 1200 Main Street, Kansas City, Missouri 64105. KCP&L is engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution, and sale of electric energy and power in those areas in Missouri certificated to it by the Missouri Public Service Commission (hereinafter "Commission"), including the City of Kansas City, Missouri, as well as in areas of eastern Kansas. KCP&L is an "electrical corporation" and "public utility" as those terms are defined in Section 386.020, RSMo 2000¹, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission as provided by law. KCP&L's Certificate of Good Standing was filed with the Commission in Case No. EM-2000-753 and is incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. KCP&L has no pending or final judgments or decisions against it from state or federal regulatory agencies or courts which involve customer service occurring with in the three

(3) years immediately preceding the filing of this application. KCP&L has no overdue

Commission annual reports or assessment fees.

4. On April 22, 2011, Veolia Energy Kansas City, Inc. ("Veolia") submitted tariffs

designed to implement a general rate increase for steam service. Veolia indicates the new steam

service rates are designed to increase its gross annual steam tariff revenues by approximately

\$1,379,000. The submitted tariffs carry an effective date of May 22, 2011.

5. On May 2, 2011, the Commission issued its Order Setting Procedural Schedule,

Notice of Hearing, and Order Directing Notice, which directed that any entity wishing to

intervene in this matter should file a motion to intervene not later than May 11, 2011.

6. KCP&L has a direct and pecuniary interest in this proceeding that is different

from that of the general public. KCP&L provides electricity in the same service area for which

Veolia is providing steam services. It is therefore important to KCP&L that Veolia's rates

appropriately reflect its cost of service.

7. For the above-stated reasons, KCP&L's interest in this proceeding is different

from that of the general public and cannot be represented by any other party to these

proceedings. Actions taken by the Commission in this proceeding may substantially affect

KCP&L's legal interests.

- 8. KCP&L's participation will aid the Commission in resolving the issues raised in this proceeding. Consequently, KCP&L's intervention and participation will promote the public interest.
- 9. Since there is insufficient information currently available to identify all issues that may arise which will affect KCP&L's interests, KCP&L reserves its right to state its position and participate with regard to any matter or issue arising in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, KCP&L respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order authorizing it to intervene in the above-captioned matter.
