

COME NOW WorldCom Technologies, Inc., n/k/a MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., Brooks Fiber Communications of Missouri, Inc., Metropolitan Fiber Systems of St. Louis, Inc., Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Kansas City, Inc., and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, herein "Movants", and hereby request that the Commission grant their Motion to Accept Late Filed Annual Reports and Treat Certain Provisions of said Reports as Highly Confidential.

These reports are resubmitted pursuant to Commission Order in this case dated November 1, 2000. The late filing of these reports will not prejudice any parties involved.


Further, pursuant to Rule 4 CSR 240-10.080(7), the aforesaid parties request that the access line counts contained in Movants ABLEC annual reports be treated as highly confidential. As grounds for requesting highly confidential treatment of these portions of the annual reports the parties state that said portions of the annual reports contain company specific, state-specific

information that is not otherwise publicly available. The information contained in these reports could be used by competitors of the aforesaid parties to determine the extent of business operations in Missouri, including the extent of network facilities, and other items that are of a competitively sensitive nature. Disclosure of this type of information to their competitors would be detrimental to Movants' business interests in Missouri. The competitively sensitive information contained in these reports is not otherwise in the public domain.


The reports are submitted herewith. The 1999 Form 10-K referred to therein was previously submitted with other reports that have been filed pursuant to this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Movants request that for the foregoing reasons, the Commission issue an order accepting the late filed annual reports and allow the filing of the identified provisions under seal.
