MOTION FOR ISSUANCE OF A PROTECTIVE ORDER

Comes now Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC"), and, in support of its motion for issuance of the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission") standard-form protective order, states as follows:

- 1. MAWC has filed with the Commission tariffs designed to increase its rates for water and sewer service.
- 2. Information which may be requested during the Staff's investigation, discovery initiated by the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel") and discovery initiated by other parties may contain customer-specific information, competitive pricing information, trade secrets and confidential, technical, financial and business information, or other material of a confidential or proprietary nature. Public disclosure of the material which the Staff, Public Counsel, or others may seek in discovery may tend to harm the interests of MAWC and its customers.
- 3. In addition, MAWC anticipates that some of the testimony and exhibits filed by itself and other parties to this proceeding may make reference to information of a confidential or proprietary nature.
- 4. Therefore, because of the potential for public disclosure of such information without a protective order in place, MAWC moves the Commission to issue in this case its standard-form protective order containing classifications of "highly confidential" and

"proprietary."

WHEREFORE, MAWC respectfully requests that the Commission:

- (a) issue the Commission's standard-form protective order containing classifications of "highly confidential" and "proprietary" to guide the parties' conduct in this case; and,
 - (b) grant such further relief as the Commission deems appropriate.
