## **MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE**

COMES NOW the Director of the Department of Manufactured Homes and Modular Units of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Director" and "Department"), by and through the Missouri Public Service Commission's Office of General Counsel, and for his Motion to Consolidate ("Motion") states as follows:

- 1. Case Nos. MX-2000-430, MX-2000-431, MX-2000-433, and MX-2000-445 all deal with changes to 240 CSR Chapter 121 that recognize the removal of recreational vehicles from the Commission's jurisdiction (See Senate Bill 19) or update terminology to reflect current industry practice. None of the proposed rulemakings have a fiscal impact on the State or any subdivision thereof or on any other public or private entity.
- 2. For administrative ease, these cases could be consolidated into one. This would facilitate the processing of these proposed rulemakings and speed their implementation if the proposed rulemakings are approved by the Commission.

WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully requests that the Commission consolidate Case Nos. MX-2000-430, MX-2000-431, MX-2000-433, and MX-2000-445.
