ORDER REJECTING TARIFF

On October 28, 2011, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to reject a tariff filed on October 25 by Mercury Voice and Data Company. The purpose of the tariff filing was to reflect the change of the company's name to Mercury Voice and Data, LLC, d/b/a Suddenlink Communications. Staff does not take issue with the company's decision to change its name, but is concerned about technical problems with the name change and the implementing tariff. Specifically, Staff indicates the tariff purports to be effective on October 31, which is less than ten days after the tariff was actually filed. Further, Staff is concerned that the filing did not include a copy of the notice of the name change provided to customers as required by the Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.062.

For the reasons identified by Staff, the Commission will reject Mercury Voice and Data's tariff filing. The company is free to refile its tariff in a manner that complies with the Commission's regulation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

The tariff submitted under Tariff File No. YL-2012-0186 on October 25, 2011,
by Mercury Voice and Data is rejected.
