

In the matter of the approval of Stoddard
County Sewer Co., Inc., for permission,
approval, and a certificate of convenience
and necessity authorizing it to construct,
install, own, operate, control, manage
and maintain a sewer system for the public
located in an unincorporated area in
Stoddard County, Missouri.

ORDER MODIFYING APPROVAL OF NOTICE

The Commission's Report and Order issued in this matter and effective
September 11, 1979, directed the Company to submit to the Commission for its
approval, prior to commencing sewer service, a proposed form of notice to its
customers informing them of the amount of the connection fee and the time period
within which such fee may be paid without interest due.

After submission of the proposed notice, the Commission by Order issued
in this matter on the 5th day of February, 1980, approved the notice.

It has now come to the Commission's attention that the notice previously
approved does not conform to the Report and Order previously issued, in that the
notice recited that if a customer does not request the sewer service and does
not pay the connection fee within one (1) year 12 percent interest charge will be
levied on the entire connection fee of \$1,035. The Report and Order granting the
certificate in this matter contemplated that the 12 percent interest charge would
only be levied on \$835 of the connection fee, or the amount attributable to the
construction of the treatment facility and the connecting sewers. It was not
contemplated that the 12 percent interest charge would be levied against the \$200
of the connection fee representing the construction of the service connection.
The Company's tariff, filed in response in the Report and Order, properly states
that the amount of the connection fee subject to the interest charge will be
\$835.

Investigation by the Commission Staff indicates that the Company will
not commence providing sewer service until July 28, 1980, whereas the notice
provides for a statement that the Company commence service in February, 1980.

The Commission is of the opinion, that to the extent recited herein, the approval of the proposed notice to the customers contained in the Commission's Order of February 6, 1980, should be modified.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the approval of the notice to the customers of Stoddard County Sewer Company in response to Ordered paragraph No. 3 of the Report and Order issued herein effective September 11, 1979, be, and the same is, hereby modified so as to approve the form of the notice attached hereto as Appendix A.

ORDERED: 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.

ORDER MODIFYING APPROVAL OF NOTICE

ARTICLE A

NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF STODDARD COUNTY SEWER CO., INC.:

TO:

You are hereby notified that Stoddard County Sewer Co., Inc. has filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission a schedule of rates, rules and regulations governing the operations of said Sewer Company, which has been approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission.

Pursuant to said schedule of rates, rules and regulations which have been approved by the Commission, Stoddard County Sewer Co., Inc. has been authorized and by law is required to collect a connection fee of \$1,035.00 for each single family residence the company has been authorized to serve.

Stoddard County Sewer Co., Inc. has commenced sewer service to the public as of the 28th day of July, 1980. Each customer will have one (1) year from the date of the commencement of service, or until the 28th day of July, 1981, to request the sewer service offered by the Company and to pay the connection fee of \$1,035.00 interest free. However, each customer who does not request the sewer service and does not pay the connection fee by the 28th day of July, 1981, will be required to pay to the Company a 12% interest charge on the portion of the connection fee representing the pro rata contribution to the construction of the treatment plant and connecting sewer, in the amount of \$835.00.
