- 2. The Commission set this matter for a hearing which was held on March 27, 1979, in the Commission's hearing room on the tenth floor of the Jefferson State Office Building, Jefferson City, Missouri.
- 3. On May 4, 1979, the General Counsel's Office filed a motion to dismiss this matter (1) for failure to file such application in a timely manner and (2) because the application for a certificate of convenience and necessity as set forth in Section 393.170 RSMo 1969 was improper and unnecessary.
- 4. On May 25, 1979, the Company filed its answer to this motion.
- 5. Because of the unresolved issues in this matter, the General Counsel requests the opportunity to pursue the case further by oral argument before the Commission in order to clearly

delineate the issues and to expedite this matter and avoid any further delay.
