NOTICE SHORTENING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND

On October 14, 1999, Citizens Long Distance Company (Citizens LD) filed proposed revisions to its PSC Mo. No. 1 Intrastate Long Distance Message Telecommunications Service Tariff (File No. 200000360). The filing bore an effective date of November 14, 1999. However, Citizens LD included a request for expedited approval of the tariff filing and requested that its tariff filing become effective on October 20, 1999, or as soon thereafter as possible.
