## VIDEO SERVICE AUTHORIZATION

On October 15, 2021, Big River Broadband, LLC (“the Company”) pursuant to Section 67.2679.7, RSMo 2016, filed a Notice of Change Application seeking to expand video service to the following political subdivisions:

Political Subdivision	Fee Amount
City of Jackson	5%
City of Cape Girardeau	5%
City of Poplar Bluff	5%
Butler County	0%

The Commission has reviewed the application filed by the Company and finds that it and the attached affidavit comply with the filing requirements set forth in Section 67.2679.7, RSMo 2016. The affidavit attached to the application represents that the company has not had contact with the office of the Commission about any substantive issue connected to the filing within 60 days before filing the application. On the basis of that representation, for good cause shown, the Commission will waive application of the pre-filing notice requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1).

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Big River Broadband, LLC is granted authority to provide video service in the franchise area of each political subdivision set forth in the application and restated above.

2. The pre-filing notice requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1) are waived.

3. Big River Broadband, LLC is granted authority to construct a video service network along, across, or on public rights-of-way for the delivery of video service to the extent the video service provider or an affiliate did not otherwise possess a valid authorization to occupy the public rights-of-way.

4. This order shall become effective when issued, after which this file may be closed.
