**RESPONSE OF KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY
TO ORDER DIRECTING FILING CONCERNING
REQUEST TO RESTORE POWER DURING PENDENCY OF COMPLAINT**

Pursuant to the order of the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri (“Commission”) directing filing in the above-captioned case and 4 CSR 240-2.080, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCPL”) hereby submits to the Commission its response to the order directing KCPL to submit a response to the request for KCPL to restore power during the pendency of the complaint in this proceeding. In support hereof, KCPL offers as follows:

1. On July 7, 2006, Mr. Broughton submitted a complaint to the Commission in the above-captioned proceeding. On July 12, 2006, the Commission issued a Notice of Complaint and Order Directing KCPL to Respond to Request to Restore Power During Pendency of Complaint (“Order Directing Response”). Pursuant to the Order Directing Response, KCPL’s response to the order was due at 1:00 p.m. on July 14, 2006. The undersigned counsel did not receive the Order Directing Response until 2:30 p.m. on July 14, 2006.

2. Shortly after receiving the Order Directing Response, the undersigned counsel received by e-mail from a third party an Order from the Commission directing KCPL to restore power to the Complainant. KCPL does not contest the Commission’s direction. In fact, when

the undersigned counsel received today's order, KCPL was preparing a response that indicated that although it had not been given an opportunity to investigate the merits of Complainant's claims it would restore power to the Complainant out of respect for the Commission and as an act of good faith in the complaint resolution process.

3. KCPL regrets not having the opportunity to respond to the Commission's Order Directing Response. KCPL hopes to receive notice of such expedited actions in a more timely manner in the future. KCPL will comply with the Commission's order to restore power during the pendency of the complaint.
